Measures 47-50 of the Trumpet 5 part. Measure 47 begins with a *rall.* marking. Measure 48 features a *ten.* marking and a box containing the number 49. ## II. THE STAR SPANGLED BANNER

Trumpet parts 9 and 10 are obligato parts and are optional. The arrangement can also be played with only 5 parts (1-4, 6).
